

Dear Camper,

The Rhode Island Department of Environmental Management (RIDEM) Division of Parks and Recreation will be experiencing an exciting new improvement to the George Washington State Campground in Glocester, Rhode Island. In response to the camper's needs of the campground, the Division will be constructing a new restroom / shower building with a septic dump station at the campground with an expecting opening on April 1, 2017.

The construction will begin on March 7, 2016 and continue throughout the summer season and fall. The construction will take place on weekdays during the hours of 7:00am until 4:00pm with very limited if any construction taking place on the weekends. The construction zone will be located near the current cabin near the beach area. The beach will be open as normal and staffed with lifeguards throughout the summer.

Please understand that there may be disruptions during this time to accommodate construction. The focus of the design and planning efforts is to make your camping experience more enjoyable for many years to come.
