STATE OF RHODE ISLAND CERTIFICATE OF COMPLIANCE:
OUT-OF-STATE TRAVEL COVID-19 TESTING & QUARANTINE REQUIREMENT

In accordance with current [executive orders](#) regarding out-of-state travelers who are coming to Rhode Island for non-work-related purposes, from a location with a high community spread rate (i.e. a state with a positivity rate of COVID-19 greater than 5%), this Certificate of Compliance must be completed prior to staying at a state campground. A list of locations with a high community spread rate can be found [here](#). The list will be updated every Monday by the Rhode Island Department of Health.

Out-of-state travelers who are coming from locations with a high community spread rate will need to self-quarantine in Rhode Island for 14 days immediately prior to their camping arrival date or until such time as they receive a negative COVID-19 test result or provide proof of a negative COVID-19 test result that was taken no longer than 72 hours prior to arrival in Rhode Island. **Please note that you cannot quarantine at a Rhode Island state campground.**

For each camping reservation, please complete this form for all site occupants and provide it at check-in.

In accordance with Rhode Island executive orders, I certify that the following is true for myself and all members in my camping party who are coming from a state with a high community spread rate as set forth on the list maintained by the RIDOH (check all that apply):

- Tested NEGATIVE for COVID-19 *in the State that I/we traveled from* at least 72 hours before arrival in Rhode Island. I understand that I may be asked to furnish proof of the negative test(s) upon request.
- Tested NEGATIVE for COVID-19 *in the State of Rhode Island* at least 72 hours prior my/our arrival to the campground. I understand that I may be asked to furnish proof of the negative test(s) upon request.
- Have completed a 14-day quarantine in Rhode Island prior to my stay at this campground.

I certify that the information above is true and accurate. Submission of this form with false information is subject to criminal penalties under Rhode Island General Laws § 11-18-1, which prohibits the giving a document to an agent, employee or public official which contains false or erroneous information, and is misdemeanor punishable by a fine not to exceed \$1,000 or by imprisonment for up to one year.
